[PROPOSED] ORDER APPROVING STIP.
REGARDING CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE
No. 12-CV-6351-TEH

1 Plaintiff Joubin Rahimi (“Plaintiff”) and defendant Nintendo of America Inc.
2 (“Nintendo”) filed a stipulation seeking to take the currently-scheduled Case Management
3 Conference and associated deadlines (including ADR deadline) off-calendar pending resolution
4 of Nintendo’s Motion to Compel Arbitration and Stay Proceedings (Dkt. No. 11) and asking the
5 Court that, in the event the Court denies Nintendo’s Motion to Compel Arbitration and Stay
6 Proceedings, after or as part of that order the Court set new dates related to the Case Management
7 Conference. Having considered the stipulation, and for good cause appearing,

8 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT THE PARTIES’ AGREEMENT IS APPROVED:

- 9 1. The Case Management Conference currently scheduled for March 18, 2013 and all
10 associated deadlines (including ADR deadlines) are taken off-calendar;
- 11 2. In the event the Court denies Nintendo’s Motion to Compel Arbitration and Stay
12 Proceedings, the parties are required to file their ADR certifications fourteen days
13 following a denial of the motion; and
- 14 3. In the event the Court denies Nintendo’s Motion to Compel Arbitration and Stay
15 Proceedings, the Court will set a new deadline for the Case Management
16 Conference and the parties will be required to file their Joint Case Management
17 Statement seven days prior to the Case Management Conference date set by the
18 Court.

19 **PURSUANT TO STIPULATION, IT IS SO ORDERED.**
