**ORDER DENYING IN FORMA
PAUPERIS APPLICATION**

Re: Dkt. No. 3

17 Plaintiff Melody Adams moves to proceed in forma pauperis (IFP). Dkt. No. 3. In
18 her IFP application, Adams answers in the affirmative question No. 3 asking whether she
19 owns cash or has money in a checking or savings account. *See id.* at 2. She fails,
20 however, to identify each account and separately state the amount of money held in each
21 account. *See id.* Adams also answers in the affirmative question No. 4 asking whether
22 she owns real estate, stocks, bonds, notes, automobiles, or other valuable property. *Id.*
23 Adams fails to describe the property and state its approximate value as required. *See id.*

24 Finding her application incomplete, the Court DENIES without prejudice Adams'
25 IFP application. Adams may re-file an amended IFP application, clarifying the above, by
26 January 21, 2013. Adams must also consent or decline the jurisdiction of a magistrate
27 judge by January 21. *See* attached consent/declination forms.
