
**MINUTE ORDER NOTING DISMISSAL

13 Plaintiff CliC Goggles, Inc. has filed a stipulation dismissing all of its claims against  
14 Starcrest Products of California, Inc., with prejudice. ECF No. 47. Starcrest has also filed  
15 stipulation jointly with Defendant Third-Party Plaintiff and Counterclaimant Blue Gem  
16 Sunglasses, Inc. in which those parties' claims against each other are dismissed without prejudice.  
17 ECF No. 48. "The plaintiff may dismiss some or all of the defendants . . . through a Rule 41(a)(1)  
18 notice." Wilson v. City of San Jose, 111 F.3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997). Dismissal is effective  
19 without court order pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii).
