17 Pursuant to Rule 16(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the parties attended a
18 Case Management Conference on May 30, 2013. After considering the Joint Case Management
19 Statement submitted by the parties and consulting with the attorneys of record for the parties and
20 good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

21 1. ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION.

22 PANEL MEDIATION. The parties are hereby REFERRED to the ADR Department for
23 the purpose of conducting a panel mediation to take place within the next ninety (90) days, if
24 possible.

25 2. INITIAL DISCLOSURES. Initial disclosures shall be exchanged on or before
26 June 13, 2013.

1 3. DISCOVERY.

2 On or before February 7, 2014 all non-expert discovery shall be completed by the parties.
3 Discovery shall be limited as follows: (a) ten (10) non-expert depositions per party; (b) twenty-
4 five (25) interrogatories per party, including all discrete subparts; (c) a reasonable number of
5 requests for production of documents or for inspection per party; and (d) a reasonable number of
6 requests for admission per party.

7 4. DISCOVERY DISPUTES.

8 Discovery disputes will be referred to a Magistrate Judge. After the parties have met and
9 conferred, the parties shall prepare a joint letter of not more than 8 pages explaining the dispute.
10 Up to 12 pages of attachments may be added. The joint letter must be electronically filed under
11 the Civil Events category of "Motions and Related Filings >Motions--General > Discovery
12 Letter Brief." The Magistrate Judge to whom the matter is assigned will advise the parties of
13 how that Judge intends to proceed. The Magistrate Judge may issue a ruling, order more formal
14 briefing, or set a telephone conference or a hearing. After a Magistrate Judge has been assigned,
15 all further discovery matters shall be filed pursuant to that Judge's procedures.

16 5. EXPERT WITNESSES. The disclosure and discovery of expert witnesses shall
17 proceed as follows:

18 A. On or before February 21, 2014, parties will designate experts in accordance with
19 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(a)(2).

20 B. On or before March 7, 2014, parties will designate their supplemental and rebuttal
21 experts in accordance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(a)(2).

22 C. On or before March 28, 2014, all discovery of expert witnesses pursuant to Federal
23 Rule of Civil Procedure 26(b)(4) shall be completed.

24 6. FURTHER CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE. A Further Case
25 Management Conference shall be held on **February 13, 2014 at 10:00 a.m.** in Courtroom 3,

3 7. PRETRIAL MOTIONS. All pretrial motions must be filed and served pursuant to
4 Civil Local Rule 7. All pretrial motions shall be heard no later than **June 26, 2014**.

5 8. PRETRIAL CONFERENCE. The final pretrial conference will be held on
6 **August 14, 2014 at 10:00 a.m.**, in Courtroom 3, 17th Floor, United States Courthouse, 450
7 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, California. Each party or lead counsel who will try the
8 case shall attend personally.

9 9. TRIAL DATE. A jury trial shall commence on **August 25, 2014 at 9:00 a.m.**, in
10 Courtroom 3, 17th Floor, United States Courthouse, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco,
11 California.
