

1 Jane Does 1 and 2 are Ms. Brown's minor children. Mr. Petersen and
2 Mr. Goldstein seek only to withdraw as counsel for Ms. Brown and
3 Jane Does 1 and 2; they will remain as counsel for Mr. Brown. Mr.
4 Petersen and Mr. Goldstein have apparently reached an impasse with
5 Ms. Brown regarding the prosecution of this case. Mot. at 1.

6 Mr. Petersen and Mr. Goldstein have given Ms. Brown oral and
7 written notice of their intention to withdraw. Id. at 2. They
8 have also provided case files to another attorney prepared to
9 represent Ms. Brown and her children. See id. at 2. However, no
10 other attorney has appeared in this case to represent Ms. Brown or
11 her children, and there is no indication that they have agreed to
12 proceed pro se. Especially given the fact that two of the
13 plaintiffs are minor children, the Court finds it inappropriate for
14 Mr. Petersen and Mr. Goldstein to withdraw until substitute counsel
15 has appeared. The motion to withdraw is therefore DENIED. Mr.
16 Petersen and Mr. Goldstein may file a Notice of Change in Counsel
17 once substitute counsel has appeared to represent Ms. Brown and
18 Jane Does 1 and 2.
