**ORDER REQUESTING
SUPPLEMENTAL SUBMISSIONS**

17 Plaintiff contends that the Court lacks subject matter jurisdiction. Our court of appeals
18 held that “where the plaintiff has pled an amount in controversy less than \$5,000,000, the party
19 seeking removal must prove with legal certainty that CAFA’s jurisdictional amount is met.”
20 *Lowdermilk v U.S. Bank Nat’l Ass’n*, 479 F.3d 994, 1000 (9th Cir. 2007); *see also Bonnel v.*
21 *Best Buy Stores, L.P.*, 881 F. Supp. 2d 1164, 1171 (N.D. Cal. 2012) (Judge Edward Chen)
22 (affidavit by Human Resources manager insufficient evidentiary support). Defendant’s counsel
23 shall make such a showing in a submission not to exceed ten pages by **TUESDAY, MAY 28 AT**
24 **NOON**. Plaintiff may respond to this by **THURSDAY, MAY 30 AT NOON**.
