**ORDER RE STIPULATION FOR
DISMISSAL OF ACTION AND
JANUARY 9 CASE
MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

The undersigned has received the parties' stipulation for dismissal (Dkt. No. 36). Counsel for plaintiff as well as defendants Jill Khiew Lo and Sobhanieh Mostakhdemin have signed this stipulation. Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), however, requires "a stipulation of dismissal signed by *all* parties who have appeared" (emphasis added). To that end, the parties should be prepared to discuss whether Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii) requires defendant Fereidoon Ghiassi — against whom default was entered — to sign the stipulation.
