CONDITIONAL TRANSFER ORDER (CTO -1)

On June 10, 2013, the Panel transferred 7 civil action(s) to the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1407. *See* F.Supp.2d (J.P.M.L. 2013). Since that time, no additional action(s) have been transferred to the Eastern District of Wisconsin. With the consent of that court, all such actions have been assigned to the Honorable Lynn S Adelman.

It appears that the action(s) on this conditional transfer order involve questions of fact that are common to the actions previously transferred to the Eastern District of Wisconsin and assigned to Judge Adelman.
