17 Plaintiff Richard Skaff and Defendant City of Sausalito, by and through
 18 their attorneys of record, file this Stipulation And Order For Dismissal pursuant
 19 to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure section 41.

20 Plaintiff filed this lawsuit on April 26, 2013.

21 Plaintiff and Defendant have entered into a “Settlement Agreement And
 22 Release” which settles all aspects of the lawsuit. The Agreement states in part
 23 that “The court shall retain jurisdiction to enforce this Agreement.” Plaintiff
 24 and Defendant stipulate to the court retaining jurisdiction to enforce the
 25 Agreement.

26 Plaintiff moves to dismiss with prejudice the lawsuit against Defendant.
 27 Defendant, who has answered the complaint, agrees to the dismissal.

28 This case is not a class action, and no receiver has been appointed.
