The Court granted the motion to dismiss filed by the United States of America, Harry Lampiris (“Lampiris”), Gary A. Jarvis (“Jarvis”), and Walter M. Holleran (“Holleran”), as well as the motion to dismiss filed by defendants the Regents of California (the “Regents”), Lampiris, Jarvis, and Holleran, but reserved ruling on whether the Court should dismiss or stay this action. The Court dismissed Lampiris, Jarvis, and Holleran as defendants from this lawsuit and substituted in the United States in their place. Moreover, the Court dismissed the Regents because there was no basis upon which to hold the Regents liable in light of the dismissal of Lampiris, Jarvis, and Holleran.

With respect to Plaintiff’s claims against the United States, the Court provided Plaintiff with an opportunity to demonstrate why his claims should be stayed, as opposed to dismissed.
