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STIPULATION REGARDING BRIEFING SCHEDULE AND HEARING DATE

1 Petitioner Joselito Casimiro (“Petitioner”) and respondents Eric Holder, Jr., Janet Napolitano,
2 John Morton and Timothy Aiken (“Respondents”), by and through their respective counsel, hereby
3 stipulate as follows:

4 1. On April 29, 2013, Petitioner filed a Petition For A Writ of Habeas Corpus claiming that
5 his counsel failed to file a Ninth Circuit petition for review, including a Request for Temporary
6 Restraining Order and Motion for Stay of Removal (Dkt. No. 1);

7 2. On the same day, this Court entered a temporary restraining order staying Petitioner’s
8 deportation (Dkt. No. 2);

9 3. On May 1, 2013, pursuant to this Court’s Order, Respondents file a Return stating their
10 position that this Court lacks jurisdiction over this matter (Dkt. No. 3);

11 4. On May 1, 2013, Petitioner filed an Amended Petition For A Writ of Habeas Corpus
12 (Dkt. No. 5, 6);

13 5. On May 2, 2013 Petitioner filed a Motion to Stay Removal (Dkt. No. 7);

14 6. On May 2, 2013, the parties appeared for a hearing before this Court, at which time this
15 Court requested briefing on Petitioner’s Amended Petition For A Writ of Habeas Corpus and Motion to
16 Stay Removal, and that the parties agree on a hearing date;

17 7. The parties have agreed that Respondents will file their Return to Petitioner’s Amended
18 Petition For A Writ of Habeas Corpus and Motion to Stay Removal (Dkt. No. 5, 6, 7) on May 29, 2013
19 and Petitioner will file his Traverse on June 12, 2013;

20 8. The parties have further agreed that this matter should be set for hearing with this Court
21 on June 19, 2013 at 2 p.m.; and

22 9. Respondents agree that they will not remove Petitioner to the Philippines until after the
23 hearing set for June 19, 2013.

1 **THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED** by and between Petitioner and Respondents
2 that Respondents will file their Return to Petitioner's Amended Petition For A Writ of Habeas Corpus
3 and Motion to Stay Removal (Dkt. No. 5, 6, 7) on May 29, 2013 and Petitioner will file his Traverse on
4 June 12, 2013 that this matter should be set for hearing with this Court on June 19, 2013 at 2 p.m.; and
5 that Respondents will not remove Petitioner to the Philippines until after the hearing set for June 19,
6 2013.
