ORDER OF TRANSFER

The acts complained of in his complaint occurred at the CMC, located in San Luis Obispo County which lies in the Central District of California. Venue, therefore, properly lies in the Central District and not in this one. <u>See</u> 28 U.S.C. § 1391(b).

Accordingly, in the interest of justice and pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1406(a), this action is TRANSFERRED to the United States District Court for the Central District of California. The Clerk of the Court shall transfer the case forthwith.
