1	completely replaces the previous complaints, plaintiff must include in his amended complaint
2	<u>all</u> the claims he wishes to present and <u>all</u> of the defendants he wishes to sue. <i>See Ferdik v</i> .
3	Bonzelet, 963 F.2d 1258, 1262 (9th Cir. 1992). Any claims not raised in the amended
4	complaint will be deemed waived. Plaintiff may not incorporate material from the prior
5	complaint by reference. Failure to file an amended complaint in accordance with this order
6	will result in dismissal of this action with prejudice for failure to prosecute. See Fed. R. Civ.
7	P. 41(b). No extensions of time will be granted, owing to the large period of time
8	afforded plaintiff. The Clerk shall terminate Docket No. 5.
