Based on the Stipulation and GOOD 12 CAUSE APPEARING, the Court hereby ORDERS as follows: 13 (1) The above-referenced action is temporarily stayed as to all parties, including defendant 14 Bayerische Motoren Werke AG ("BMW AG") for forty-five (45) days, up to and including August 18, 15 2014 to accommodate settlement discussions among the parties. This stay order shall apply to all aspects **16** of the case, including the July 11, 2014 response deadline for BMW AG's responsive pleading to the TAC. 17 If the stay is lifted or the case otherwise proceeds without resolution on August 18, 2014, BMW AG will 18 have 14 days to file a responsive pleading to the TAC. 19 The parties are ordered to file a joint status report, on or before August 18, 2014, as to the (2) 20 status of their settlement negotiations.
