17 Before the Court is the parties' "Agreed Administrative Motion, Stipulation and
18 [Proposed] Order," filed September 24, 2013, "to Exceed Page Limits for Oppositions and
19 Replies on BWM of North America, LLC's Motions to Dismiss and Strike Set for Hearing on
20 November 1, 2013." Having read and considered the parties' administrative motion, the
21 Court rules as follows.


22 As set forth in the administrative motion, defendant has filed a motion to dismiss and
23 a motion to strike. The motion to dismiss is twenty pages in length, and the motion to strike
24 is sixteen pages in length. In their pending administrative motion, the parties seek leave for
25 plaintiffs to file a thirty-page opposition to each motion, and for defendant to file a twenty-
26 page reply to each opposition. The parties fail, however, to identify any good cause for
27 exceeding the pages limits set forth in the Local Rules of this District, see Civil L.R. 7-3,
28 and no such cause is evident from the face of defendant's motions.

1 Accordingly, the administrative motion is hereby DENIED, and the parties are
2 DIRECTED to comply with the page limits set forth in Civil Local Rule 7-3.

3 Finally, because plaintiffs may have relied on the stipulation in preparing their
4 opposition, the Court hereby EXTENDS the deadline for plaintiffs to file their opposition
5 briefs from September 27, 2013 to October 1, 2013, and EXTENDS the deadline for
6 defendant to file their replies from October 11, 2013 to October 15, 2013.

7 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
