17	Defendants' counsel shall participate in a telephone conference, to be scheduled by the ADR Unit as			
18	soon as possible but no later than July 5, 2013.			
19	Plaintiff and Defendants' counsel shall be prepared to discuss the following subjects:			
20	(1) Ider	Identification and description of claims and alleged defects in loan documents		
21	(2) Pros	Prospects for loan modification.		
22	(3) Pros	Prospects for settlement.		
23	The parties need not submit written materials to the ADR Unit for the telephone conference.			
24	In preparation for the telephone conference, Plaintiff shall do the following:			
25	(1) Rev	iew relevant loan documents an	d investigate the claims to determine whether they

27	(2) If P	(2) If Plaintiff is seeking a loan modification to resolve all or some of the claims,		
28	Plai	Plaintiff shall prepare a current, accurate financial statement and gather all of the

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request. Further, Plaintiff shall immediately notify Defendants' counsel of the request for a loan modification.

(3) Provide counsel for Defendants with information necessary to evaluate the prospects for loan modification, in the form of a financial statement, worksheet or application customarily used by financial institutions.

In preparation for the telephone conference, counsel for Defendants shall do the following.

- (1) If Defendants are unable or unwilling to do a loan modification after receiving notice of Plaintiff's request, counsel for Defendants shall promptly notify Plaintiff to that effect.
- (2) Arrange for a representative of each Defendant with full settlement authority to participate in the telephone conference.

The ADR Unit will notify the parties of the date and time that the telephone conference will be held. After the telephone conference, the ADR Unit will advise the Court of its recommendation for further ADR proceedings.
