10 This Court is in receipt of the Parties' joint letter, dated September 26, 2014, concerning
11 Defendants' request that Plaintiff be ordered to produce documents relevant to a number of
12 discovery requests. (See Dkt. 42 at 5.) It appears that some or all of Defendants' requests have
13 been resolved by agreements to produce documents. (See *id.* at 5, 7 (Plaintiff agrees to produce
14 documents "reflecting its knowledge and awareness of Defendants' use of the [allegedly]
15 infringing marks, without restricting responsive documents by any date limitations or by
16 jurisdiction" and "reflecting its enforcement activities in the United States with no date
17 restriction." (emphasis in original)).) Therefore, the Parties shall file each request still at issue, if
18 any, "in full, followed immediately by the objections and/or responses thereto" as detailed in
19 Local Civil Rule 37-2, by October 10, 2014, at 1:00 p.m. The Court does not require any
20 additional argument or briefing on this issue. The Parties are advised that should the Court
21 determine that a hearing is necessary, it will be scheduled for October 21, 2014, at 2:00 p.m., in
22 Courtroom E, 15th Floor, San Francisco.
