18 Now before the Court is Plaintiff Octavian Marka, LLC's 19 ("Plaintiff") ex parte application for an order releasing the in 20 rem defendant vessel, the M/T Marka, from arrest and for dismissal 21 of this action without prejudice. ECF No. 26 ("Ex Parte App."). 22 Plaintiff's counsel has filed a declaration of non-opposition on 23 behalf of one of the directors of Defendant Marka Shipping Ltd. 24 ("Defendant"), ECF No. 28, though it remains unclear if this 25 director has the authority to speak on behalf of Defendant. Defendant has yet to make a formal appearance in this action. 26 The 27 Court held a hearing on the matter on August 5, 2013. For the reasons set forth at the hearing, the Ex Parte Application is 28

United States District Court For the Northern District of California DENIED without prejudice. The Court grants Plaintiff leave to refile an application. Among other things, the amended application should specify to whom the M/T Marka is being released. The Court also grants Plaintiff leave to file under seal the "confidential settlement" referred to in the Ex Parte Application. For future filings, the Court advises Plaintiff to follow the guidance set forth by the Court at the hearing.
