ORDER FOR SERVICE BY MARSHAL

Plaintiff filed a Motion to Proceed in Forma Pauperis, which the Court granted. *See* Dkt. No. 5. In that Order, the Court stated that “[i]f, after completing its review, the Court determines that the complaint is not subject to dismissal pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2), it will order service of the complaint by the Marshal.” The Court has completed its review and finds that the complaint is not subject to dismissal.
