1 Pursuant to Civil Local Rules 7-12 and 16-2(d) of the Northern District of California,
2 Plaintiff Stephanie Alexander (“Plaintiff”), Defendant Pacific Maritime Association (“PMA”),
3 Defendant International Longshore and Warehouse Union (“ILWU”) and Defendant ILWU Local
4 10 (collectively, the “Parties”), by and through their respective counsel of record, file this
5 stipulation to continue the Initial Case Management Conference currently set for October 15,
6 2013 at 2:00 p.m.

7 WHEREAS, on August 27, 2013, this Court set an Initial Case Management Conference
8 for October 15, 2013 at 2:00 p.m.;

9 WHEREAS, the Court’s August 27, 2013 Case Management Conference Order and N.D.
10 Local Rule 16-10(a) require lead trial counsel for each party to attend the Initial Case
11 Management Conference;

12 WHEREAS, Robert Jon Hendricks is lead trial counsel for PMA in this matter;

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Hendricks is lead trial counsel in another matter in which a two-week

17 WHEREAS, N.D. Local Rule 16-2 permits the Parties to seek relief from the Court’s case

20 counsel; and

21 WHEREAS, during the Rule 26(f) early meeting of counsel the Parties conferred
22 regarding a proposed new date for the Initial Case Management Conference in this matter and
23 Plaintiff, ILWU, and ILWU Local 10 do not oppose a continuance of the Initial Case
24 Management Conference.


