**STIPULATION AND [PROPOSED]
 ORDER CONTINUING CASE
 MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

1 WHEREAS, the above-captioned consolidated action is a proposed class action alleging
2 violations of the federal securities laws against Vocera Communications, Inc., certain individual
3 officers and directors of the Company, and certain investment banks that served as underwriters
4 in connection with the Company's initial public offering (collectively, "Defendants");

5 WHEREAS, on September 23, 2013, this Court issued an order resetting the date for the
6 initial case management conference from October 31, 2013 to January 23, 2014;

7 WHEREAS, on November 20, 2013, this Court issued an order appointing Baltimore
8 County Employees' Retirement System and Arkansas Teacher Retirement System (together, the
9 "Retirement Systems") as Lead Plaintiff, and approving the selection of Lead Plaintiff's counsel;

10 WHEREAS, Lead Plaintiff and Defendants are in the process of meeting and conferring
11 on a proposed schedule for the filing of a consolidated complaint and associated briefing schedule
12 in connection with Defendants' anticipated motion(s) to dismiss the consolidated complaint;

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to the Private Securities Litigation Reform Act of 1995, Pub.L. No.
14 104-67, 109 Stat. 737 (1995) (the "Reform Act"), unless otherwise ordered by the Court,
15 discovery in this action is stayed during the pendency of any motion to dismiss (15 U.S.C. § 78u-
16 4(b)(3)(B)); and

17 WHEREAS, counsel in the above-captioned action respectfully submit that good cause
18 exists to vacate the existing January 23, 2014 initial case management conference and associated
19 ADR deadlines until and unless such time as the consolidated complaint has been filed and this
20 matter survives any motion(s) to dismiss;

21 IT IS ACCORDINGLY STIPULATED, pursuant to Civil L.R. 7-12, by and between the
22 undersigned counsel for the parties, that:

- 23 i. Pursuant to Civil L.R. 16-2, the Initial Case Management Conference scheduled for
24 January 23, 2014 be vacated, along with any associated deadlines under the Federal Rules
25 of Civil Procedure and Local Rules, to be rescheduled for a date that is 30 days after entry
26 of a Court order ruling on Defendants' anticipated motion(s) to dismiss the consolidated
27 complaint, or such other date as the Court shall determine to be appropriate; and
28 ii. all associated ADR Multi-Option Program deadlines likewise be deferred.

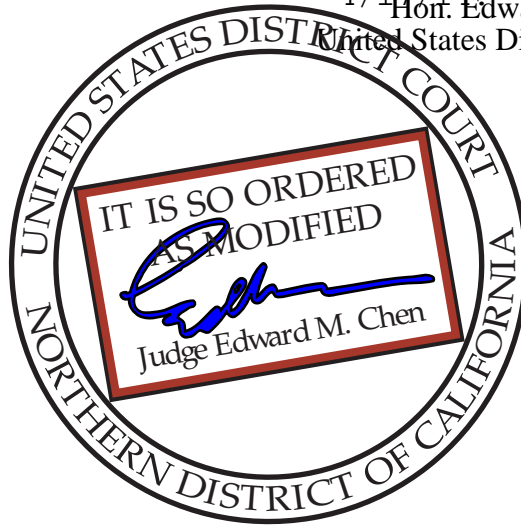
