

recommended allocation of the special master's fees among the parties. Any objections to or motions regarding the special master's report and recommendation must be filed by JULY 26 AT 3 NOON, to be heard on the normal 35-day track, and shall not exceed TEN PAGES in length. The 4 response to any such objection or motion shall be due SEVEN DAYS from the filing thereof and 5 shall also not exceed TEN PAGES in length. No reply briefing, please.

4. The Court will then review and consider any timely objections to or motions regarding the special master's report and recommendation pursuant to Rule 53(f). An order on this dispute over attorney's fees will follow.

9 5. Ex parte communications with the special master should be avoided if possible. 10 Any objection to an ex parte communication or motion to disqualify must be filed within SEVEN 11 CALENDAR DAYS of discovery.

6. Any proposed modification to this order must be promptly raised in a joint letter brief, not to exceed THREE PAGES in length, to be filed only after the parties have met and conferred — either in person or telephonically — under the special master's supervision.

7. Judge Kramer's request for a waiver of PACER fees is GRANTED.
