Plaintiffs shall have forty-five (45) days to file their Amended Complaint from the date the Court orders appointment of Lead Plaintiff and that briefing on the motion to dismiss shall follow, giving each party 45 days to file their opening motion and opposition, respectively, and giving defendants 30 days to file their reply brief. Dkt. No. 13. The Order also provides that after the Court appoints Lead Plaintiff, that the parties meet and confer regarding the specific deadline dates ("given the foregoing provision to accommodate the holidays") and to select a mutually agreeable hearing date, Dkt. No. 13, ¶ 6.
