Docket No. 453. The Court has reviewed the Revised Draft 15 Notices, and resolves the issues raised by the parties as follows. First, with respect to the opt-out mechanism, the language of the pre-addressed e-mail will 16 be: "Please exclude me from this class action." 17 18 Second, Plaintiffs' counsel requests the inclusion of counsel's contact information in the 19 notice to non-class members. Docket No. 453 at 3-4. The Court denies this request. 20 Third, the parties are unable to agree on an e-mail address for class members who wish to opt-out. The e-mail address will be "uberclassexclude@[Notice Administrator's domain]," unless 21 the parties mutually agree on an e-mail address. Opt-outs should be sent directly to the Notice 22 23 Administrator, not to Uber. 24 /// 25 /// 26 /// 27 ///
