24 conferred through their respective counsel regarding the motion;

25 AMEC and SSG now stipulate that:

26 (1) AMEC and SSG request an Order from the court staying arbitration pending this
27 Court’s ruling on Count 3 of AMEC’s claim for relief in the complaint (Declaratory judgment that

4 below, AMEC shall request the court take the Motion to Stay Arbitration off calendar.
