D). STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1). On Mother's Day, May 12, 2012, Plaintiff (Nigerian-American) alleges that Defendant's female employee (Irish, Jewish or Italian-American) bullied, defamed, shoved and ousted her after Defendant stole Plaintiff's 50 pictures in Defendant's store at the Grove in Los Angeles (LA). On or before May 12, 2012, Plaintiff alleges that Defendant's female security guard (Salvadorian-American) assaulted, battered, falsely imprisoned, sexually harassed, and sexual assaulted her in the same location. On or before October 21, 2012, Plaintiff alleges that Defendant's two female employees (Irish, Jewish or Italian and African American) retaliated against her inside Defendant's store in Santa Monica at 3<sup>rd</sup> Promenade because she reported them to their corporate office in San Francisco. Plaintiff alleges that they bullied and ousted her. Plaintiff alleges that Defendant stole more than 3,000 pictures and 3,000 notes, including 24 books on her

1 note pad that she saved via the ICLOUD on the IPAD that she bought from Defendant's  
2 store in LA (Century City mall ) in July 2012 which she registered under her first name,  
3 middle name and day of birth (amandauche21@gmail.com) on August 20, 2103. Plaintiff  
4 alleges that someone grabbed her backpack consisting of her IPAD, wallet, mini-laptop,  
5 disk containing 24 books, make-up kit, perfumes, Deodorant, etc at Union Station on the  
6 same day. She filed a report with LAPD and Deputy Sheriffs. Due to Defendant's  
7 conduct, Plaintiff alleges that she suffered enormous trauma and fell down, injuring her  
8 neck, legs and back. For these reasons, Defendant was negligent. Both a personal injury  
9 claim and a negligence claim entail a duty, a breach of that duty, proximate cause and  
10 an injury. She was a past and present customer. However, Defendant breached. What's  
11 more, they injured her several times. Her injuries include burglaries on Mother's Day  
12 and August 20, 2013. Plaintiff alleges that Defendant planted a monitoring device on her  
13 IPAD and stole her note pad, pictures, emails etc. She begged Defendant to replace the  
14 IPAD or return them via telephone (Yolanda) and two visits to Century City (two male  
15 Irish or Italian-Americans, James) on August 28, 23 and September 2, 2013 respectively.  
16 However, they refused. Please expedite this case. Your Honor, it does not belong in the  
17 Appeal's court. It was dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute. Given that  
18 postal workers tampered with her mail, SHE did not receive them. What's more,  
19 Plaintiff added new information. Thank you, Your Honor.

12 II). PERSONAL JURISDICTION

13 1). Plaintiff alleges that this court has personal jurisdiction. See Milliken v. Meyer.

14 III). DISCRIMINATION IN PUBLIC PLACES

15 (42 USC 1983 and Section 2000a of Title 42, Chapter 21 of 42 USC 21)  
16 prohibits discrimination in public places.

17 IV). PRAYER FOR RELIEF

18 Plaintiff would like to be compensated for assault, battery, breach of contract,  
19 bullying, negligence, false imprisonment, burglaries, retaliation, humiliation, emotional  
20 distress, discrimination, sexual harassment, and sexual assault based upon national  
21 origin for twenty million dollars. Most of all, Plaintiff would like Defendant to replace  
22 her IPAD, return the note pad consisting of her 3,000 notes, 24 books, 3050 pictures, and  
23 pay for medical treatment with a Chiropractor for her injuries. Hence, Plaintiff has  
24 been further injured by loss of her reputation. These acts were malicious and  
25 oppressive, justifying an additional award of punitive damages so that Defendant will  
26 not engage in such conduct in the future and make an example of her. For such other  
and further relief as the court may deem just and proper. Thank you, Your Honor.
