The Notice of Request for Voluntary Dismissal seeks a 21 court order dismissing the action with prejudice. Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a) 22 permits voluntary dismissal of an action without court order when the defendant has not 23 answered the complaint or moved for summary judgment. Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A). The 24 defendant here has not answered the complaint or moved for summary judgment, so an 25 order of the Court is not required for plaintiff to dismiss its case. Even were it necessary, 26 the Court cannot enter a dismissal or judgment because defendant has not consented or 27 declined the jurisdiction of a magistrate judge under 28 U.S.C. § 636(c). 28 Case No. 13-cv-04337 NC ORDER REGARDING DISMISSAL
