Defendants, who ask the Court to hear their motion to stay on an expedited basis. (Docket No. 70.) Defendants seek a stay of discovery in this action, pending resolution of the motions to dismiss. Plaintiff opposes the motion to shorten time, and he argues that discovery may commence pursuant to Federal Rule Civil Procedure 26(d)(1). "[T]he district court has inherent power 'to control the disposition of the causes on its docket with economy of time and effort for itself, for counsel, and for litigants." United States v. United States District Court for Northern Mariana Islands, 694 F.3d 1051, 1058 (9th Cir. 2012) (quoting Landis v. N. Am. Co., 299 U.S. 248, 254 (1936)). Based on this inherent power, and in the interest of judicial economy and efficiency, the Court HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The pending motions to dismiss shall be heard on Friday, April 25, 2014, at 9:00 a.m., in Courtroom 5, Second Floor, 1301 Clay Street, Oakland, California.

1		If the Court finds the moti-	ons suitable for disposition without oral argument, it
2		shall notify the parties in a	dvance of the hearing.
3	2.	The Court expresses no op	inion on the merits of the motions to dismiss.
4		However, because the reso	plution of the motions to dismiss may or may not affect
5		the manner in which the ca	ase will proceed, the Court HEREBY CONTINUES
6		case management conferen	nce scheduled for March 28, 2014, to Friday, June 6,
7		2014 at 11:00 a.m., in Cou	artroom 5, Second Floor, 1301 Clay Street,
8		Oakland, California. The	e parties' joint case management conference statement
9		shall be due by no later that	an Friday, May 30, 2014. All deadlines associated
10		with that case managemen	t conference, including commencement of discovery,
11		are continued as well.	
12	3.	In light of these Orders, D	efendants' motion to shorten time (Docket No. 70) and
13		motion to stay (Docket No	. 76) are DENIED AS MOOT.
