The parties agree to hold the ADR session by:

- the presumptive deadline *(The deadline is 90 days from the date of the order referring the case to an ADR process unless otherwise ordered.)*
- other requested deadline 120 days after ruling on early motion for summary judgment.

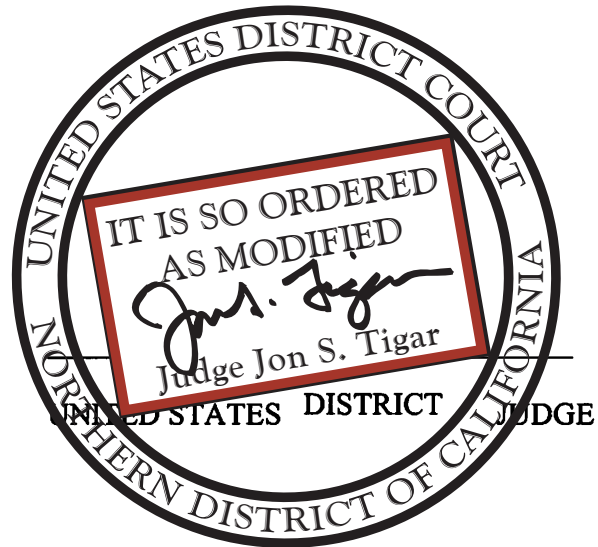


