

On November 6, 2013, the clerk filed as a new prisoner action a letter by plaintiff complaining of inadequate medical care. Plaintiff was advised that failure to file the requested items within 28 days would result in dismissal of the action.

More than 40 days have elapsed; however, plaintiff has not provided the court with the requisite items or sought an extension of time to do so. The action is DISMISSED without prejudice.

The clerk shall close the file and terminate all pending motions as moot.


