**STIPULATION REGARDING

10 finish responding to the outstanding discovery requests and to allow Facebook adequate time to
11 review his responses and depose Mr. Tarquini.

12 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED that the discovery cutoff will be extended
13 to October 2, 2014. This stipulation does not affect the other existing case deadlines set by the
