ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Plaintiffs previously failed to respond to Defendants' motion for a stay, and at a case management conference on April 14, 2014, the Court cautioned Plaintiffs' counsel that he must be sure to file an opposition or a statement of non-opposition in response to all future motions. Plaintiffs' counsel assured the Court that he would timely respond to all motions going forward. Plaintiffs' response to Defendants' motion to quash was due by April 25, 2014.
