The IFP application is 14 15 incomplete because plaintiff failed to file a Certificate of Funds completed and signed by an authorized prison officer, and a prison trust account statement detailing transactions for the last six 16 months. Accordingly, the action is DISMISSED without prejudice for failure to respond to the 17 18 Court's order and for failure to prosecute under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b). Any 19 motion to reopen **must** contain the documents listed above or full payment for the filing fee. Plaintiff's IFP application (Docket No. 8) is DENIED without prejudice.
