The court notified petitioner in writing on that date that the action was deficient because he did not pay the requisite \$5.00 filing fee or, 14 15 instead, submit a signed and completed court-approved in forma pauperis application, including a completed certificate of funds in the prisoner's account 16 17 and a copy of the prisoner's trust account statement for the last six months. 18 Petitioner was advised that failure to file the requested items within 28 days would 19 result in dismissal of the action. 20 More than 40 days have elapsed; however, petitioner still has not filed the 21 requisite items, or sought an extension of time to do so.
