20	4)	The parties are advised that they	should not call the Court with substantive
21	requests. All motions and requests must be in writing, filed, and comply with the		
22	Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Civil Local Rules. Any such filing must cite		
23		the specific rule under which the	relief is requested.
24	5)	The parties are hereby referred to	o court-sponsored mediation.
