

**ORDER SETTING
SCHEDULE ON REMAND**

The mandate from the court of appeals in this action has issued (Dkt. No. 42). By **DECEMBER 29**, plaintiff may renew its motion for an extension of the deadline within which to file post-judgment motions. This request must be brought as a formal motion, noticed on the thirty-five day calendar. It shall be supported by *sworn* statements explaining the good cause for granting a further extension, including an explanation for its request for a further extension *after* the deadline had already passed and of its diligence with regard to defendant's appearance at the examination.
