1 management conference statement and initial disclosures depend on the outcome of the motion to  
2 dismiss and, in the interest of efficiency, the parties wish to defer those tasks until the motion to  
3 dismiss and strike is decided;

4 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED that, subject to the Court's approval and pursuant to Rule  
5 26(a)(1)(C) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Local Rule 6-2, the Initial Case  
6 Management Conference shall be rescheduled for December 12, 2014, or such date as the Court  
7 deems appropriate to accommodate a ruling on the pending motion and sufficient time after the  
8 ruling for the parties to meet the requirements under Rule 26(f) for the conference of counsel,  
9 preparing the CMC statement and initial disclosures.
