ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PERMISSION TO BRING CERTAIN ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS INTO THE FEDERAL COURTHOUSE

Plaintiff Michelle Norsworthy has filed a motion seeking (a) an allocation of sixty minutes to present oral argument at the hearing on the motion for preliminary injunction, and (b) the right to bring certain electronic equipment and other materials into the courthouse for the hearing.
