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**STIPULATION**

Sohi of the Contra Costa County Counsel's Office, hereby stipulate that the due-date for Plaintiff's opposition to Defendants' motion to dismiss, which was due on July 16, 2014, be extended to July 17, 2014, and that the due date for Defendants' reply, currently due on July 23, 2014, be extended to July 24, 2014.
