18	of Defendants' failure to respond to the Court's show cause order, and because it found

20	to judgment as a matter of law. See Order Granting MSJ (dkt. 22). Defendants ask the Court
21	to set aside the judgment, asserting that they were not home in time to see the Court's Order

to Show Cause, and arguing that there is a conflict in the dates on some of the government's

documents. See generally Void Summary Judgment For Improper Serving Time (dkt. 26).

The Court hereby DIRECTS the government to respond by Friday, October 3, 2014 to 24 Defendants' assertions about the dates. 25
