ORDER NOTING WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION TO DISMISS: GRANTING IN PART STIPULATION

Re: ECF Nos. 35 & 36

The court construes the parties' stipulation, ECF No. 36, as representing to the court that Defendant's motion to dismiss the first amended complaint, ECF No. 35, will soon be mooted by the filing of a second amended complaint. Since the parties have stipulated to the filing of a second amended complaint, amendment is permitted by Rule 15(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
