15	No. 15-16337.	
16	On November 17, 2015, the Ninth Circuit issued an order in that case granting "[t]he	
17	parties' joint motion for a full remand pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g)." Dkt.	
18	No. 29.	
19	Pursuant to that order, the Court now remands this case to the Commissioner of the Social	
20	Security Administration for a de novo hearing.	
21	The Clerk is requested to enter final judgment in favor of plaintiff and against defendant,	
22	and to close the case. See Shalala v. Schaefer, 509 U.S. 292, 302 (1993) ("A sentence-four	
23	remand is a judgment for the plaintiff.").
