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14	On April 29, 2014, the clerk filed as a new prisoner action a letter by
15	plaintiff complaining of improper medical care at Salinas Valley State Prison. On

17	because he did not file an actual complaint or pay the requisite filing fee or,
18	instead, submit a signed and completed court-approved in forma pauperis (IFP)
19	application. Plaintiff was advised that failure to file the requested items within 28
20	days would result in dismissal of the action.
21	More than 30 days have elapsed; however, plaintiff has not provided the
22	court with the requisite items or sought an extension of time to do so. The action
23	is DISMISSED without prejudice.
24	The clerk shall close the file and terminate all pending motions as moot.
