1 This stipulation is entered into by and between Plaintiffs Joan Ambrosio, et al.
2 (“Plaintiffs”) and Defendant Cogent Communications, Inc. (“Defendant”) (collectively, the
3 “Parties”) through their counsel of record as follows:

4 **WHEREAS**, following the Rule 16(b) Case Management Conference, on October 9,
5 2014, this Court set forth the following briefing schedule for Plaintiffs’ intended FLSA collective
6 action and Rule 23 class action certification motions (Dkt. 30):

- 7 • May 29, 2015. Deadline for Plaintiffs to file their motion for Rule 23 class
8 certification and FLSA collective action certification;
- 9 • June 12, 2015. Deadline for Defendant to file its opposition to Rule 23 class
10 certification and FLSA collective action certification;
- 11 • June 19, 2015. Deadline for Plaintiffs to file their reply, if any, to Defendant’s

- 8 • August 7, 2015. Deadline for Plaintiffs to file a reply, if any, to Defendant's
9 oppositions;
- 10 • August 20, 2015. Hearing on Plaintiffs' motion for Rule 23 class certification and
11 motion for FLSA collective action certification.
