The motion seeks 19 to schedule the conference in early December because reportedly by that point, "the parties will 20 be in a far better position to assess whether the NFL can meaningfully satisfy its document 21 production obligations far enough in advance of the March 25 deadline" for a class certification 22 motion (Dkt. No. 83 at 4). 23 24 25

Given the undersigned judge's standing order, the motion is **DENIED** (see Dkt. No. 24 at ¶ 25). This, however, is without prejudice to plaintiffs' counsel later requesting discovery relief through the procedures set forth in the standing order.
