**ORDER CONTINUING ORDER TO
SHOW CAUSE RE:
DISQUALIFICATION and
GRANTING REQUEST TO STAY
THE CASE**

21 On January 5, 2015, the Court ordered Kevin Senn to show cause why he should not
22 be disqualified from representing the other defendants in this case due to a potential or
23 actual conflict of interest. Dkt. No. 40. In response, defendants Randolph and Mona
24 McConville requested that the Court postpone all court deadlines with 60 days so that Senn
25 Law, p.c. can withdraw as counsel for Randolph and Mona McConville and they can retain
26 new, separate counsel. Dkt. No. 42. Plaintiff has not opposed this request.

27 The Court STAYS this case, effective immediately, until March 20, 2015. The
28 parties may explore settlement during the stay and may use the services of Magistrate Judge
Donna M. Ryu when she is available. The Court will issue a separate order referring



1 Randolph and Mona McConville to the Federal Pro Bono Project for the purpose of finding
2 counsel who would represent them on pro bono basis.

3 The Court will hold a further case management conference on April 1, 2015, at 10:00
4 a.m. in Courtroom A, 15th Floor, U.S. District Court, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, San
5 Francisco, California. The parties must file an updated joint case management statement at
6 least one week prior to the conference. The January 5 order to show cause is continued to
7 April 1, 2015.
