 23 Decline Intervention, and any election to intervene or decline intervention filed by the United  
 24 States', all of which Relator shall serve upon Defendants only after the unsealing of this matter  
 25 and the service of the Complaint;

26 Should the Relator or Defendants propose that this action be dismissed, settled, or  
 27 otherwise discontinued, the Court will solicit the written consent and approval of California  
 28 before ruling or granting its approval;
