12 In a notice dated May 27, 2014, the Clerk of the Court
13 directed Plaintiff to complete a civil rights complaint form and an
14 in forma pauperis (IFP) application, and told him that he must
15 complete these documents within twenty-eight days or his action
16 would be dismissed. The Clerk sent Plaintiff a blank civil rights
17 complaint form as well as a prisoner's IFP application.

18 More than twenty-eight days have passed, and Plaintiff has
19 not filed the necessary documents or otherwise communicated with the
20 Court.

21 Accordingly, this action is DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
22 The Clerk shall terminate all pending motions and close the file.
