23 Plaintiffs WILLIE YORK and CAROLYN YORK MILES (“Plaintiffs”) and Defendants
 24 NATIONSTAR MORTGAGE LLC doing business as Champion MORTGAGE COMPANY
 25 erroneously sued as Champion MORTGAGE (“Champion”), BANK OF AMERICA, N.A.
 26 (“BANA”), THOMAS PERKINS (“Perkins”), REVERSE MORTGAGES OF CALIFORNIA,
 27 INC., and SURETY BONDING COMPANY OF AMERICA (collectively “Parties”) submit a

1 Stipulated Request to Continue the October 12, 2017 Hearing on the Defendants' Respective
2 Motions for Summary Judgment and Associated Deadlines.

3 Upon review of the Joint Stipulation, and good cause appearing, the Court orders as
