22	diversity jurisdiction exists, given that both plaintiff and two of the named defendants are		
23	citizens of California. Therefore, defendants must show cause within fourteen days of this		
24	order, in a brief not to exceed ten pages, why this action should not be remanded to state		
25	court for lack of federal subject matter jurisdiction. Plaintiff must respond or state its		
26	nonopposition, in a brief not to exceed ten pages, within seven days of defendants'		
27	submission.
